Energy Assistance

- For Valley REC members only
- For hardships created by a death, illness, fire, hospitalization
- Up to \$500 applied to member's account
- Residential accounts only
- Includes Valley Rec's Secondary Service Grant program to assist members in making repairs to service connection. (Secondary Service grant amount up to \$700)
- Energy Assistance applications may be made by the prospective recipient or on behalf of that recipient with his/her permission

Civic & Community Programs

- Organizations or entities that serve Valley REC members – fire companies, Junior Achievement, emergency management units
- Up to \$1,000 in funding
- Must state specific equipment or project need
- Funding is not for regular budget/operational expenses

Education

- Benefits Valley REC members or student populations within the Valley REC service area
- Up to \$1,000 in funding
- Category includes the co-op's Brighter Future scholarship and Youth Tour programs
- Teachers may request grant funds for support materials and special projects
- Funding is not for regular budget/operational expenses
