Co-op's Head of Member Services Returns from Third Military Deployment to the Middle East

DOUG ROLES, VALLEY RURAL ELECTRIC Cooperative's (REC) vice president of member services, returned in September from his third deployment to the Middle East with the Pennsylvania Army National Guard. Roles was mobilized with approximately 500 soldiers from the 28th Infantry Division's Headquarters Battalion, based in Harrisburg.

Now, he is back to work at the cooperative's corporate office near Huntingdon.

"The co-op has been very supportive of my military service," Roles says. "I appreciate the way my co-workers took on my workload, in addition to their own normal duties, during my absence."

Roles serves as editor of Valley REC's local pages in *Penn Lines* magazine. He also plays a significant role in planning co-op events, such as the annual meetings and district nominating meetings, and manages media relations.

Some of his work for the cooperative mirrors what he has done for the military. Roles, who holds the rank of master sergeant, is a print journalist in the division's public affairs office.

He spent most of his deployed time in Qatar, participating in the same mission as his deployment to Kuwait in 2018. The headquarters battalion again provided mission command with several thousand troops conducting security operations throughout the Middle East. Additionally, the battalion conducted training directly with partner-nation military units in countries, including Kuwait, Jordan, United Arab Emirates, Qatar and Egypt.

Roles has served in the Pennsylvania National Guard

since 2002. In addition to the 2018 mobilization, he previously deployed to Iraq in 2008-2009 with the division's 56th Stryker Brigade Combat Team. He has also participated in overseas training in Egypt, France, Lithuania and South Korea. During the summer of 2022, he spent nearly four weeks at the National Training Center at Fort Irwin, Calif., as part of a 20-soldier senior trainer team.

"Certainly, I missed my family while overseas," Roles says, "but I can also say I genuinely missed my Valley REC family. I'm excited to be part of the co-op team again and look forward to serving our members."

Doug and his wife, Jody, have a 21-year-old son, Hunter. They live in McVeytown, Mifflin County. •
