Electric Cooperative Youth Tour

Trip date: June 15-20, 2026

For students who will have just completed their junior year and will be seniors in the 2026-27 school year.

For decades Valley Rural Electric Cooperative, Inc. has sponsored high school juniors on the annual National Rural Electric Cooperative Association Youth Tour to Washington, D.C. Valley's students join other students from electric cooperatives in Pennsylvania and New Jersey and travel by motorcoach together to the nation's capital. There they meet high school juniors from across the nation, learn about the cooperative business model, meet with legislators and tour national attractions and monuments.

Valley REC sponsors juniors from member households, enrolled in public, private and home school programs across its eight-county service territory. Juniors whose parents/guardians are seasonal VREC account holders are also eligible to apply. Valley REC's Youth Tour committee will select recipients based on academic achievement, as well as participation in extracurricular activities and/or community service.
